The Sins of Black Adam

Black Adam has brought the player along on his quest to free his wife's soul from the devil Neron. It features fun fights in a gothic, lava-strewn hellscape with new demons, devils, and Deadly Enemies.

I incorporated a unique feature: this story is "narrated" by a radio host, like it's an old-fashioned radio serial. This also has different lines for heroes and villains, which is always fun.

Free Moving

(The player and Black Adam traverse the underworld.)

Billy Batson (radio narration): Billy Batson, boy reporter for W.H.I.Z. Radio, recapping the events that led up to Kahndaq being claimed as a domain of the Lord of the Underworld: Neron! **Black Adam**: My beloved wife, Isis, has been imprisoned by death for too long! No more chicanery, no more waiting. Today, I will set her free myself!

Cutscene

(Neron casually strolls towards Black Adam. A demon trails after.)

Neron: It seems as though your quest to take a soul has awakened, well, Greed. A Deadly

Enemy, to be sure.

Greed: Greed consumes!

(Greed attacks!)

Free Moving

(Combat begins.)

Billy Batson (radio narration): Undeterred, Black Adam and his ally fought the Deadly Enemy of Man: Greed! I don't think the blatant symbolism bothered him even a little bit! (players fight & defeat Greed.)

Cutscene (Heroes)

(Neron approaches again.)

Black Adam: Do you yield?! I will not stop!

Neron: Yield? Far from it. But, I thought perhaps we'd be better off making a bargain, a trade.

Black Adam: I came prepared to trade. This virtuous soul for hers.

Neron: A true rarity! But in my experience, a Virtuous soul is merely a Deadly soul who has not yet lived long enough.

Cutscene (Villains)

(Neron approaches again.)

Black Adam: Do you yield?! I will not stop!

Neron: Yield? Far from it. But, I thought perhaps we'd be better off making a bargain, a trade.

Black Adam: I came prepared to trade. This deadly soul for hers.

Neron: This is your offer? A Deadly soul who would be mine soon anyway? Black Adam, no, no!

(Unsurprisingly, Black Adam's deal-with-the-devil backfires!)
