Unedited Dialogue

Cutscene

(DeSaad teleports in.)

Edited Dialogue

Cutscene

(Desaad teleports in.)

DeSaad (cuttable): My current test subjects tolerate so little pain, and where's the fun in that? **Static**: Hold up. You're buyin' Bang Babies just so you can hurt them for fun?! Not even Ebon deserves that...

DeSaad: It's not about deserve. It's about science.

Free Moving

Desaad (Free Moving): Step into the portal. Try to rescue them. I want to feel your anguish when you fail.
